NOTES for Staff Salut is a resource for the IWB which includes, games, songs and stories as well as lesson plans and assessment sheets. It is aimed at the non- specialist and the phonic and grammar elements will be particularly helpful in fulfilling the PoS for MFL.

The Salut resource has many printables but do checkout the packs by Y3 first. There may well be something similar already made. There are also other books and dictionaries there.

NB The recently purchased KAPOW online curriculum resource also has French lesson plans and power points etc with teacher video guides. These seem really good too. Lesson plans are detailed and provide good activity ideas and include phonics and grammar.
