At St Brigid's, we take all concerns or complaints very seriously and always endeavour to find solutions with the minimum of disruption.



Therefore, before there is a chance of a complaint being made, we always encourage parents/carers to discuss their concerns with the class teacher in the first instance. If, after such a conversation, the concern has not been resolved, parents/carers are encouraged to contact the school office to arrange to speak to Mrs Tyler (Headteacher) or Mrs Richards (Senior Assistant Headteacher).

We feel that by engaging in a sensible and measured conversation, that most problems can be easily resolved. We do, however, acknowledge that this may not always be the case. When concerns/complaints cannot be resolved in this way the school will follow the complaints and concern procedure as recommended by the Local Authority and sanctioned by the Governing Body.
