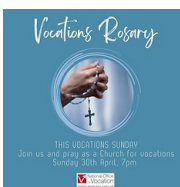


## Vocations Sunday

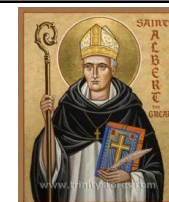

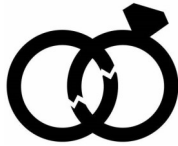
