What is Prisoners' Sunday? Prisoners' Sunday is a time to think about how we as individuals, as a Church and as communities are serving those affected by imprisonment. Prisoners, people with convictions, and their children and families often find themselves on the margins of our society. The Gospel message on Prisoners' Sunday reminds us that Jesus is the cornerstone of our lives and of our communities. Alongside our concern for the wellbeing of those in prison, we



remember that families in our parishes and neighbourhoods may be enduring anxious worry, isolation and perhaps hardship while a loved one is incarcerated. According to Home Office statistics, there were 87,685 prisoners in our country (Home Office Stats 22 September 2023).

On Prisoners Sunday we are asked to pray for those in prison, their families , those who work in prisons and victims of crime.


Baptism Certificates
