

FIRST HOLY COMMUNIONS

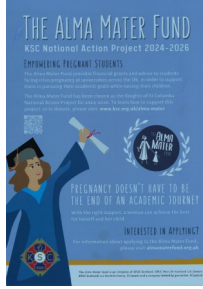
A reminder that the next meeting for the parents and children on our First Holy Communion programme will be after Mass today. All parents and children are expected to attend the meeting and Mass.

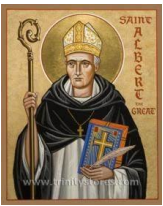
ARCHDIOCESAN PILGRIMAGE TO ROME - CURRENTLY FULLY SUBSCRIBED
